(YOUNG ADULT-Camp Fee is \$40)** We are offering an EARLY BIRD SPECIAL of \$90.00 if your registration is postmarked two weeks before the start of the camp session that you wish to attend. **YOUNG ADULT EARLY BIRD SPECIAL OF \$30.** The balance is to be paid upon arrival at camp. *All registrations must be submitted two weeks before your week of camp is to begin!* This gives the registrar time to send out the final bulletin with important information the camper and the parent need to know. This also gives the director time to make sure they have sufficient supplies for classes, sports and all other activities as well as sufficient staff. Registration will be accepted on the opening day of camp as long as space permits. If space is not available, registration will be denied to those who have not pre-registered. Do NOT let this happen to your child. **REGISTER EARLY!!**

CAMP RULES

- 1) Every person must keep the schedule.
- 2) All campers must attend Bible classes, worship services, program activities, and recreation activities unless excused by the camp nurse or director.
- 3) All campers and staff must be in their villages after lights out unless they have special permission from the camp director.
- 4) Appropriate dress will be expected by all campers, staff, and visitors.
- 5) Absolutely no tobacco, alcohol, or non-prescribed controlled substances are allowed. These are grounds for IMMEDIATE expulsion.
- 6) No one will leave the camp grounds, even with parents, without permission from the camp director.
- 7) Destruction of property or wildlife is not permitted.
- 8) Weapons, radios(including cassettes, cd players, mp3, etc), televisions, cell-phones, pagers, laser pointers, and all kinds of fireworks are not permitted.
- 9) The directors reserve the right to send home any person who is having a detrimental effect on the camp session. No refunds will be made.
- 10) Boys are not allowed in the girls' villages and girls are not allowed in the boys' villages. Practical

Visitors

We welcome visitors for evening worship services, which are held at 7:30 each evening **except for Grades 3 & 4. We strongly discourage parents from visiting only because it creates a lot of homesickness with this age group.** We ask that all visitors report in with the camp director upon arrival at camp. All visitors are expected to observe all camp rules. Visitors must abide by the camp dress code. No visitors will be allowed in the villages unless they have permission from the director. All visitors must promptly leave the campgrounds at the time designated by the camp director at the evening services. NO

Arrival at Camp

We will begin checking in campers at 2:00pm on Sunday afternoon. Please do not plan on arriving any earlier. When you arrive, you will need to check in at the registration table in the main pavilion before you go to your cabin. You need to bring your Sunday evening meal. You may eat when you choose. The first meal served by the camp will be breakfast on Monday. Any camper taking prescription medications should report to the director and/or nurse upon arrival. No drugs will be allowed in cabins. Dress Code

The camp is primitive, therefore, rough clothing is recommended. MODEST clothing is required. Halter tops & muscle shirts will not be permitted. There will be no bare mid-ribs permitted. Shirts with suggestive pictures and/or words on them that are not in keeping with Christian principles will not be permitted. Shorts and cutoffs may be worn at KNEE length each day until evening services. Please check your Final Bulletin for your directors more detailed dress code.

What to Bring

You will need to bring the following: Bedding, Sleeping Bag, Flashlight, Insect Repellent, Pillow, Extra Blanket, Towels, Soap, Toothpaste, and other toilet articles, Small Notebook, Pen or Pencil, Bible, Sturdy Shoes, (more than one pair) clothes suitable for christian camping, and a non-electric alarm clock. You will need to bring several pairs of long pants or jeans for evening services and activities since no shorts are permitted at the evening service.

What NOT to Bring

The following items are not consistent with the goals of Christian Camping and we cannot be responsible for damage and/or loss of these items so please leave them at home: Radios, tape players, cd players of any kind, any kind of Nintendo or Sega Game Boys, cell-phones, pagers, lap-top computers. In addition, DO NOT BRING: TOBACCO, ALCOHOL, OR DRUGS OF ANY KIND, SHAVING CREAM(prohibited except for shaving purposes), ANY TYPE OF WEAPON(INCLUDING POCKETKNIVES), ANY TYPE OF FIREWORKS. POSSESSION AND/OR USE OF THESE ITEMS WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM CAMP!

Immediate Dismissal

- 1) Possession and/or use of any drug, tobacco or alcohol
- 2) Participation in the destruction of camp property
- 3) Unauthorized entrance of boys into girls' villages or girls into boys' villages.
- 4) Possession and/or use of fireworks
- 5) Possession of any pornographic materials
- 6) Activity that would endanger the safety of any camper or staff member(including threats of violence)

READ CAREFULLY and complete both pages of the registration form. If this form is incomplete or the conditions above are not agreed to by the camper(applicant) and parent, the camper will not be admitted to NOCYC.
